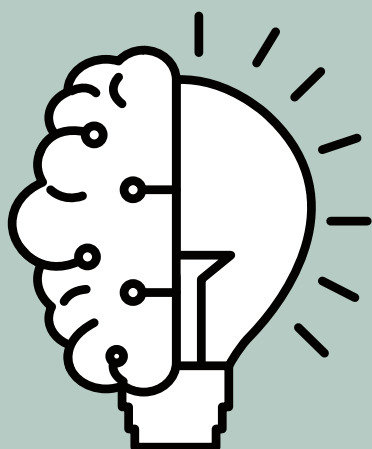
UNGRADING
